

~JUBAL (31)

(Ju'bal) [possibly, Ram]

- Son of Lamech and Adah, descendant of Cain. As founder of all those who handle the harp and the pipe, **Jubal** may have invented both stringed and wind instruments, or perhaps he founded a profession, which gave considerable impetus to the progress of music.
- Afterward Cain had intercourse with his wife and she became pregnant and gave birth to Enoch. Then he engaged in building a city and called the city's name by the name of his son Enoch. (**Genesis 4:17**)
- Later there was born to Enoch Irad. And Irad became father to Mehujael, and Mehujael became father to Methushael, and Methushael became father to Lamech. (**Genesis 4:18**)
- And Lamech proceeded to take two wives for himself. The name of the first was Adah and the name of the second was Zillah. (**Genesis 4:19**)
- In time Adah gave birth to **Jabal**. He proved to be the founder of those who dwell in tents and have livestock. (**Genesis 4:20**)
- And the name of his brother was **Jubal**. He proved to be the founder of all those who handle the harp and the pipe. (**Genesis 4:21**)
