- A name employed in a proverbial utterance of Balaam to refer to the tribe of the Kenites.
- But there will come to be one to burn Kain down. How long will it be till Assyria will carry you away captive? (Numbers 24:22)

- Incidentally Heber the Kenite had separated from the Kenites, the sons of Hobab, whose son-in-law Moses was, and he had his tent pitched near the big tree in Zaanannim, which is at Kedesh. (Judges 4:11)
