~KEHELATHAH (15)

(Ke-he-la'thah) [from a root meaning, congregation]

- One of the places where the Israelites encamped while wandering in the wilderness.
- Next they pulled away from Rissah and went camping in Kehelathah. (Numbers 33:22)
- Then they pulled away from Kehelathah and went camping in Mount Shepher. (Numbers 33:23)
- Its exact location is currently unknown.
