

**~KELITA 1 (21)**

**(Ke-li'ta) [possibly from a root meaning, too short, that is, dwarfed]**

- **One of the Levites of Ezra's day who recognized their guilt in taking foreign wives and therefore sent them away. He is also called Kelaiah.**
- **And of the Levites, Jozabad and Shimei and **Kelaiah**, that is, Kelita, Pethahiah, Judah and Eliezer. (**Ezra 10:23**)**
- **These all had accepted foreign wives, and they proceeded to send away wives along with sons. (**Ezra 10:44**)**
