~KEZIAH (19) (Ke-zi'ah) [possibly, Cassia]

- The second of the three daughters of Job born after his severe trial and subsequent restoration and blessing by Yehowah.
- And he went calling the name of the first Jemimah and the name of the second Keziah and the name of the third Keren-happuch. (Job 42:14)
- The Hebrew word for *cassia* was used as a feminine name, likely because of the fragrance of cassia, and may have been given to this girl as an indication of her beauty.
- And no women were found as pretty as Job's daughters in all the land, and their father proceeded to give them an inheritance in among their brothers. (Job 42:15)
