- Yehowah God is a killer and also a preserver of life.
- Yehowah is a Killer and a Preserver of life, a Bringer down to Sheol, and He brings up. (1 Samuel 2:6)
- Jehu was asked if it went all right with Zimri the killer of his Lord.
- And Jehu himself came in by the gate. She now said; Did it go all right with Zimri the killer of his lord? (2 Kings 9:31)
- People must understand clearly the reasons for Yehowah's bringing of sword against all false religion. The sword has been polished, and books such as this one reflect clearly Yehowah's reasons for acting against all false religion. It must be a sharp sword to cut through false reasoning and lies. It will then be placed into the hands of a killer, the nations, which have bloodied all of the earth by their way.
- And one gives it to be polished, in order to wield it with the hand. It, a sword has been sharpened, and it, it has been polished, in order to give it into the hand of a killer. (Ezekiel 21:11)
- Though Yehowah blessed Ephraim, the firstborn tribe of Israel with a productive land, yet because of Ephraim's error their sons were destined to be given over to a killer, and they would be removed from off this productive land.
- Ephraim, whom I have seen like Tyre planted in a pasture ground, even Ephraim is destined to a bringing out of his sons even to a killer. (Hosea 9:13)
- Jesus now talks about Jerusalem as the center of true worship in all the earth, and refers to how in his pre-human existence he shepherded this nation of Israel in the manner, that a mother hen gathers her chicks close around her for protection and care. Yet as a people, they did not want this care, and rejected time and again, also the loving assistance of the prophets, and killed most of them.

- Jerusalem, Jerusalem, the killer of the prophets and stoner of those sent forth to her, how often I wanted to gather your children together, the way a hen gathers her chicks together under her wings! But you people did not want it. (Matthew 23:37)
- Then Jesus made another illustration, showing what he was like in heaven before coming to the earth. He compared himself there to a mother hen who looks after her brood of chicks, keeping them close by shepherding them with her wings. Yet he called Jerusalem the killer of all the prophets, and the stoner of all those who had been sent forth to her.
- Jerusalem, Jerusalem, the killer of the prophets and stoner of those sent forth to her, how often I wanted to gather your children together in the manner that a hen gathers her brood of chicks under her wings, but you people did not want it! (Luke 13:34)
