

~KIRIATH-SEPHER (32)

(Kir'i-ath-se'pher) [Town of the Book]

- The ancient name of Debir, a priestly city in the territory of Judah, about 13 kilometers (8 miles) Southwest of Hebron.
- Then he went up from there to the inhabitants of Debir. Now the name of Debir before that was **Kiriath-sepher**. (**Joshua 15:15**)
- And Caleb proceeded to say; Whoever strikes **Kiriath-sepher** and does capture it, I shall certainly give him Achsah my daughter as a wife. (**Joshua 15:16**)
- And to the sons of Aaron the priest they gave the city of refuge for the manslayer, namely, Hebron, and its pasture ground, also Libnah and its pasture ground. (**Joshua 21:13**)
- And Holon and its pasture ground, and Debir and its pasture ground. (**Joshua 21:15**)
- And they marched on from there against the inhabitants of Debir. Now the name of Debir before that was **Kiriath-sepher**. (**Judges 1:11**)
- Then Caleb said; Whoever strikes **Kiriath-sepher** and does capture it, why, I will give him Achsah my daughter as a wife. (**Judges 1:12**)
