~KORE 2 (26) (Ko're) [possibly, Bald, Baldness]

- A Levite, the son of Imnah and the gatekeeper to the east of the temple in King Hezekiah's day. He was in charge of the voluntary offerings of the true God, to give Yehowah's contribution and the most holy things, and had other men under his control.
- And Kore the son of Imnah the Levite was the gatekeeper to the east, in charge of the voluntary offerings of the true God, to give Yehowah's contribution and the most holy things. (2 Chronicles 31:14)
- And under his control there were Eden and Miniamin and Jeshua and Shemaiah, Amariah and Shecaniah, in the cities of the priests, in office of trust, to give to their brothers in the divisions, equally to great and small. (2 Chronicles 31:15)
- Apart from their genealogical enrollment of the males from three years of age upward, of all those coming to the house of Yehowah as a daily matter of course, for their service by their obligations according to their divisions. (2 Chronicles 31:16)
