[English, difficult, strenuous, arduous, awkward, Opposite of, easy]

- Jesus told his disciples that he was dispatching them to reap from the labor of others, the Israelite system.
- I dispatched you to reap what you have spent no **labor** on. Others have **labored**, and you have entered into the benefit of their **labor**. (**John 4:38**)
- Paul stated that he had **labored** in excess of all the other Apostles.
- But by God's undeserved kindness I am what I am. And his undeserved kindness that was toward me did not prove to be in vain, but I **labored** in excess of them all, yet not I but the undeserved kindness of God that is with me. (**1 Corinthians 15:10**)
