

**~LACKED (36)**

**[English, was short of, did not have, was deficient in, needed, required, Opposite of, had]**

- Through the fourth year long march through the wilderness the Israelites **lacked** nothing.
- For Yehowah your God has blessed you in every deed of your hand. He well knows of your walking through this great wilderness. These forty years Yehowah your God has been with you. You have not **lacked** a thing. (**Deuteronomy 2:7**)
- And for forty years you provided them with food in the wilderness. They **lacked** nothing. Their very garments did not wear out, and their feet themselves did not become swollen. (**Nehemiah 9:21**)
- The survivors of Jerusalem's destruction wanted to turn back to worship the queen of the heavens having learned nothing from their discipline by Yehowah, saying that when they worshiped her they **lacked** nothing. This showed that their worship was only one aimed at selfish gain.
- And from the time that we ceased to make sacrificial smoke to the queen of the heavens and pour out drink offerings to her we have **lacked** everything, and by the sword and by the famine we have come to our finish. (**Jeremiah 44:18**)
- Paul now says, that he rejoices, that they have given thought to his counsel previously given to them, which for a time they could not address, but now they are addressing it fully. This has been manifested in their kind gift to him.
- I do rejoice greatly in the Lord that now at last you have revived your thinking in my behalf, to which you were really giving thought, but you **lacked** opportunity. (**Philippians 4:10**)
