## ~LAMECH 2 (59) (La'mech)

- A descendant of Seth, son of Methuselah and father of Noah.
- And Methuselah lived on for a hundred and eighty-seven years. Then he became father to Lamech. (Genesis 5:25)
- And Lamech lived on for a hundred and eighty-two years. Then he became father to a son. (Genesis 5:28)
- And he proceeded to call his name Noah, saying; This one will bring us comfort from our work and from the pain of our hands resulting from the ground which Yehowah has cursed. (Genesis 5:29)
- Adam, Seth, Enosh. (1 Chronicles 1:1)
- Kenan; Mahalalel, Jared. (1 Chronicles 1:2)
- Enoch, Methuselah, Lamech. (1 Chronicles 1:3)
- Noah, Shem, Ham and Japheth. (1 Chronicles 1:4)
- The lifetimes of this Lamech and Adam likewise overlapped. Lamech had faith in God, and after calling his sons name Noah, probably meaning, Rest, Consolation, he uttered the words,
- And he proceeded to call his name Noah, saying; This one will bring us comfort from our work and from the pain of our hands resulting from the ground which Yehowah has cursed. (Genesis 5:29)
- These words found fulfillment when the curse on the ground was lifted during Noah's lifetime.
- And Yehowah began to smell a restful odor, and so Yehowah said in his heart; Never again shall I call down evil upon the ground on man's account, because the inclination of the heart of man is bad from his youth up, and never again shall I deal every living thing a blow just as I have done. (Genesis 8:21)

- Lamech had other sons and daughters. He lived 777 years, dying about five years before the Flood.
- And after his fathering Noah Lamech continued to live five hundred and ninety-five years. Meanwhile he became father to sons and daughters. (Genesis 5:30)
- So all the days of Lamech amounted to seven hundred and seventy-seven years and he died. (Genesis 5:31)
- His name is listed in the genealogy of Jesus Christ at;
- Son of Cainan, son of Arpachshad, son of Shem, son of Noah, son of Lamech. (Luke 3:36)
