

**~LASHA (20)**  
**(La'sha)**

- A place mentioned in the earliest Canaanite boundary description.
- So the boundary of the Canaanite came to be from Sidon as far as Gerar, near Gaza, as far as Sodom and Gomorrah and Admah and Zeboiim, near **Lasha**. (**Genesis 10:19**)
- Its exact location is uncertain. Either **Lasha** was near Zeboiim [NW, JP [1962 ed.]] or the Canaanite boundary extended from the area around Zeboiim as far as **Lasha**. AT, RS, JB
- On the basis of Jerome's identification and Jewish tradition, many place **Lasha** at Callirrhoe, near the eastern shore of the Dead Sea below the **Wadi Zarqa Ma`in**. Others link **Lasha** with Laish in Dan.
