## ~LASHA (20) (La'sha)

- A place mentioned in the earliest Canaanite boundary description.
- So the boundary of the Canaanite came to be from Sidon as far as Gerar, near Gaza, as far as Sodom and Gomorrah and Admah and Zeboiim, near Lasha. (Genesis 10:19)
- Its exact location is uncertain. Either Lasha was near Zeboiim [NW, JP [1962 ed.]] or the Canaanite boundary extended from the area around Zeboiim as far as Lasha. AT, RS, JB
- On the basis of Jerome's identification and Jewish tradition, many place Lasha at Callirrhoe, near the eastern shore of the Dead Sea below the Wadi Zarqa Ma`in. Others link Lasha with Laish in Dan.
