(Le'vi) [Adherence, Joined]

- **A tax collector**
- But as he was passing along, he caught sight of **Levi** the son of Alphaeus sitting at the tax office, and he said to him; Be my follower. And rising up he followed him. (**Mark 2:14**)
- Now after these things he went out and beheld a tax collector named **Levi** sitting at the tax office, and he said to him; Be my follower. (**Luke 5:27**)
- Also, **Levi** spread a big reception feast for him in his house, and there was a great crowd of tax collectors and others who were with them reclining at the meal. (**Luke 5:29**)
- **Who became an apostle of Jesus Christ and was otherwise known as Matthew.**
- Next, while passing along from there, Jesus caught sight of a man named Matthew seated at the tax office, and he said to him; Be my follower. Thereupon he did rise up and follow him. (**Matthew 9:9**)
- The names of the twelve apostles are these. First, Simon, the one called Peter, and Andrew his brother, and James the son of Zebedee and John his brother. (**Matthew 10:2**)
- Philip and Bartholomew, Thomas and Matthew the tax collector, James the son of Alphaeus, and Thaddaeus. (**Matthew 10:3**)
- Simon the Cananaean, and Judas Iscariot, who later betrayed him. (**Matthew 10:4**)
