[English, dishonesty, deceit, falsehood, fabrication, deception, Opposite of, honesty]

- If a man lies down with a virgin he is to obtain her as wife without fail.
- Now in case a man seduces a virgin who is not engaged, and he actually lies down with her, he is to obtain her without fail as his wife for the purchase price. (Exodus 22:16)
- Anyone who lies down in a house where there is leprosy is unclean, and should wash his garments.
- And whoever lies down in the house should wash his garments, and whoever eats in the house should wash his garments.

 (Leviticus 14:47)
- If a man lies with a woman and her menstrual flow begins, he must be unclean for seven days.
- And if a man lies down with her at all and her menstrual impurity comes to be upon him, he must then be unclean seven days, and any bed upon which he might lie down will be unclean. (Leviticus 15:24)
- And the menstruating woman in her uncleanness, and anyone who has a flow of his running discharge, whether a male or a female, and whether a man who lies down with an unclean woman. (Leviticus 15:33)
- Now in case a man lies down with a woman and has an emission of semen, when she is a maidservant designated for another man, and she has not in any way been redeemed nor has freedom been given her, punishment should take place. They should not be put to death, because she was not set free. (Leviticus 19:20)
- A man who lies down with his father's wife, both of them should be put to death without fail.
- And a man who lies down with his father's wife has laid bare the

nakedness of his father. Both of them should be put to death without fail. Their own blood is upon them. (Leviticus 20:11)

- Similarly for a man who lies down with his daughter-in-law.
- And where a man lies down with his daughter-in-law, both of them should be put to death without fail. They have committed a violation of what is natural. Their own blood is upon them. (Leviticus 20:12)
- Or lies down with another man.
- And when a man lies down with a male the same as one lies down with a woman, both of them have done a detestable thing. They should be put to death without fail. Their own blood is upon them. (Leviticus 20:13)
- Or with a woman who is menstruating knowingly.
- And where a man lies down with a menstruating woman and does lay bare her nakedness, he has exposed her source, and she herself has laid bare the source of her blood. So both of them must be cut off from among their people. (Leviticus 20:18)
- A man would lies down with his uncle's wife both he and her should remain childless.
- And a man who lies down with his uncle's wife has laid bare the nakedness of his uncle. They should answer for their sin. They should die childless. (Leviticus 20:20)
- And another man actually lies down with her and has an emission of semen, and it has been hidden from the eyes of her husband and has remained undiscovered, and she, on her part, has defiled herself but there is no witness against her, and she herself has not been caught. (Numbers 5:13)
- Yehowah God is not a man so that he should tell lies, he always speaks the truth.
- God is not a man that he should tell lies, neither a son of mankind that he should feel regret. Has he himself said it and will he not do it, and has he spoken and will he not carry it out? (Numbers 23:19)

- The Law covered a case where a man lies down with a virgin girl.
- In case a man finds a girl, a virgin who has not been engaged, and he actually seizes her and lies down with her, and they have been found out. (Deuteronomy 22:28)
- Cursed is the man who lies down with his father's wife.
- Cursed is the one who lies down with his father's wife, because he has uncovered the skirt of his father. And all the people must say; Amen! (Deuteronomy 27:20)
- Cursed is anyone who lies down with a beast.
- Cursed is the one who lies down with any beast. And all the people must say; Amen! (Deuteronomy 27:21)
- Cursed is anyone who lies down with his sister.
- Cursed is the one who lies down with his sister, the daughter of his father or the daughter of his mother. And all the people must say; Amen! (Deuteronomy 27:22)
- Cursed is anyone who lies down with his mother-in-law.
- Cursed is the one who lies down with his mother-in-law. And all the people must say; Amen! (Deuteronomy 27:23)
- Delilah told Sampson that he was trifling with her, and speaking lies to her.
- Subsequently Delilah said to Samson; Look! You have trifled with me that you might speak lies to me. Now tell me, do please, with what you can be tied. (Judges 16:10)
- After that Delilah said to Samson; Up till now you have trifled with me that you might speak lies to me. Do tell me with what you can be tied. Then he said to her; If you will weave the seven braids of my head with the warp thread. (Judges 16:13)
- Naomi told Ruth to watch where Boaz lies down after the threshing of the grain, and go there to him and lie down at his feet.

- And it should occur that when he lies down, you must also take note of the place where he lies down, and you must come and uncover him at his feet and lie down, and he, for his part, will tell you what you ought to do. (Ruth 3:4)
- Bathsheba told David that if he did not take immediate action then when he lies down in death, she and her son Solomon would be considered offenders and likely killed by Adonijah who wanted to be Israel's next king.
- And it will certainly occur that as soon as my lord the king lies down with his forefathers, I myself and also my son Solomon shall certainly become offenders. (1 Kings 1:21)
- When the man of the true God told the woman that she was to have a son, she asked him not to tell her lies, for she did not put faith in his word to her.
- Then he said; At this appointed time next year you will be embracing a son. But she said; No, my master, O man of the true God! Do not tell lies in connection with your maidservant. (2 Kings 4:16)
- Job asked where a man goes when he lies vanquished in death, where is he then.
- But an able-bodied man dies and lies vanquished, and an earthling man expires, and where is he? (Job 14:10)
- Job showed that he would not tell lies against his own judgment, for though his wounds were incurable, he felt he had not deserved his treatment through any transgression of his own.
- Against my own judgment do I tell lies? My severe wound is incurable though there is no transgression. (Job 34:6)
- Leviathan lies down under the thorny lotus tree, in a concealed place of reeds and a swamp.
- Under the thorny lotus trees it lies down, in the concealed place of reeds and the swampy place. (Job 40:21)
- Happy is the man that trusts Yehowah God alone, and does not look toward defiant men and those falling away to lies.

- Happy is the able-bodied man that has put Yehowah as his trust and that has not turned his face to defiant people, nor to those falling away to lies. (Psalms 40:4)
- The wicked ones have been perverts from the womb, telling lies since they were young ones.
- The wicked ones have been perverts from the womb, they have wandered about from the belly onward, they are speaking lies. (Psalms 58:3)
- Yehowah God swore in his holiness, that to David he would not tell lies, his promises could be counted upon.
- Once I have sworn in my holiness, to David I will not tell lies. (Psalms 89:35)
- A false witness launches forth lies, and Yehowah God hates such ones.
- A false witness that launches forth lies, and anyone sending forth contentions among brothers. (Proverbs 6:19)
- The prostitute waits in the public squares for her prey, a young man, for there she lies in wait.
- Now she is outdoors, now she is in the public squares, and near every corner she lies in wait. (Proverbs 7:12)
- A faithful witness will not lie, while a false witness launches forth mere lies.
- A faithful witness is one that will not lie, but a false witness launches forth mere lies. (Proverbs 14:5)
- A true witness is delivering souls, but a deceitful one launches forth mere lies. (Proverbs 14:25)
- Anyone launching forth mere lies will not go free from punishment.
- A false witness will not be free from punishment, and he that launches forth lies will not escape. (Proverbs 19:5)

- The false witness will not be free from punishment, and he that launches forth lies will perish. (Proverbs 19:9)
- Do not show yourself craving the tasty dishes of a king, for it is the food of lies.
- Do not show yourself craving his tasty dishes, as it is the food of lies. (Proverbs 23:3)
- The prostitute lies in wait like a robber, and she increases the treacherous ones among mankind.
- Surely she, just like a robber, lies in wait, and among men she increases the treacherous ones. (Proverbs 23:28)
- Yehowah now tells Hosea, that his people will come to experience only woe, for they have fled from his loving care, and his fine counsel toward them. They have transgressed against him through the worship of idols, and by following after mere men. He had redeemed his people from their sins, and led them to a land of promise, yet they continued to speak out lies against him.
- Woe to them, for they have fled from me! Despoiling to them, for they have transgressed against me! And I myself proceeded to redeem them, but they themselves have spoken lies even against me. (Hosea 7:13)
- Now last of all, Yehowah God turns his attention to Judah who at the time of Amos' prophecy is still walking in faithfulness, but who will later regress to conduct even worse than Israel, or Samaria. Also on account of three or four revolts against him, he is determined to bring upon her a judgment.
- They have rejected the Law of Yehowah God and have not kept his regulations. They continue to follow nothing, but the lies of their forefathers, and this is causing them to wander as a people before their God. They are thus too attached to their traditions, and refuse to change when new understanding comes to the fore before them. They cling tenaciously to the understanding of their forefathers, refusing any change.
- This is what Yehowah has said; On account of three revolts of Judah, and on account of four, I shall not turn it back, on account

of their rejecting the Law of Yehowah, and because they did not keep his own regulations, but their lies, after which their forefathers had walked, kept making them wander. (Amos 2:4)

- The Kingdom of God lies not in speech and flowery words of human wisdom, but it is about the power of God's Holy Spirit to change men's lives.
- For the kingdom of God lies not in speech, but in power. (1 Corinthians 4:20)
- Thus even today, whenever Moses is read, this same veil lies over their hearts, for the Law Covenant condemns to death, and no man could keep it flawlessly, but the New Covenant gives life, and Christians through love of the spirit of God, readily obey its divine principles, and thus fulfill the hope of the Law Covenant, that of producing a nation of kings and priests.
- In fact, down till today whenever Moses is read, a veil lies upon their hearts. (2 Corinthians 3:15)
- Paul warns, that then these men will speak lies against the truth of God, and they will be marked by a bad conscience, just as if they had been branded with a hot branding iron.
- By the hypocrisy of men who speak lies, marked in their conscience as with a branding iron. (1 Timothy 4:2)
- The city lying foursquare indicates it being solidly founded, balanced by Yehowah's four primary qualities of love, justice, wisdom and power. The English term, furlong is actually the word stadia in the Greek text, from which we derive the English word, stadium.
- The Holy City is therefore equivalent in size to 144 million stadiums on its base level, but it also builds upward 12,000 times this amount for a total of 1 trillion 728 billion stadiums in total volume and each stadium is capable of holding 144,000 people. Certainly enough to hold all of the human family no matter how large it gets. It is large enough to hold 1 times ten to the 22 power of people as a convention center.
- And the city lies foursquare, and its length is as great as its breadth. And he measured the city with the reed, twelve thousand furlongs, its length and breadth and height are equal.
