~LIFETIME (88)

[English, life, time, lifespan, natural life, duration, existence]

- A man was not to take two sisters as wives during the same lifetime.
- And you must not take a woman in addition to her sister as a rival to uncover her nakedness, that is, besides her during her lifetime. (Leviticus 18:18)
- Sampson put to death more Philistines during his death than throughout his entire lifetime.
- And Samson proceeded to say; Let my soul die with the Philistines. Then he bent himself with power, and the house went falling upon the axis lords and upon all the people that were in it, so that the dead that he put to death in his own death came to be more than those he had put to death during his lifetime. (Judges 16:30)
- Being under the goodwill of Yehowah God lasts a lifetime.
- Because being under his anger is for a moment, being under his goodwill is for a lifetime. In the evening weeping may take up lodging, but in the morning there is a joyful cry. (Psalms 30:5)
- A man who during his lifetime is blessing his own soul, will be lauded by others, because he did well for himself.
- For during his lifetime he kept blessing his own soul; And people will laud you because you do well for yourself. (Psalms 49:18)
- The Psalmist showed, that he would bless Yehowah God during his lifetime.
- Thus I shall bless you during my lifetime, in your name I shall raise my palms. (Psalms 63:4)
- I will praise Yehowah during my lifetime. I will make melody to my God as long as I am. (Psalms 146:2)

- Yehowah keeps satisfying mankind throughout their lifetimes with what is good, renewing them continually.
- Who is satisfying your lifetime with what is good, your youth keeps renewing itself just like that of an eagle. (Psalms 103:5)
- Because all men have one eventuality, death, their hearts are bent on badness, and there is madness in their heart throughout their lifetime.
- This is what is calamitous in all that has been done under the sun, that, because there is one eventuality to all, the heart of the sons of men is also full of bad, and there is madness in their heart during their lifetime, and after it, to the dead ones! (Ecclesiastes 9:3)
- Then the Greater Abraham, Yehowah God will say to them, that they should remember that during their lifetimes they had all the best of everything, and by contrast then, that Lazarus got the worst of everything. So that now Lazarus is having comfort and they are in anguish.
- This is how it will be for all those who take enjoy every material advantage now, but who disregard the finer spiritual principles guiding our lives. Their advantage is a fleeting one, one that will not endure, while the blessing of Lazarus is everlasting. They will only see this when their lives are over and judgment comes, thus leaving them in anguish that they did not act differently during their time of testing. Also this anguish will be everlasting, for it will never end.
- But Abraham said; Child, remember that you received in full your good things in your lifetime, but Lazarus correspondingly the injurious things. Now, however, he is having comfort here but you are in anguish. (Luke 16:25)
