

~LIFTS (34)

[English, raises, picks up, hauls up, elevates, boosts]

- Yehowah from the ashpit **lifts** up the poor and lowly ones.
- A Raiser of a lowly one from the dust, from the ashpit he **lifts** up a poor one, to make them sit with nobles, and a throne of glory he gives to them as a possession. For to Yehowah belong earth's supports, and he places upon them the productive land. (1 Samuel 2:8)
- Yehowah causes a tempestuous wind to **lift** up the ocean's waves.
- How he says the word and causes a tempestuous wind to arise, so that it **lifts** up its waves. (Psalms 107:25)
- Yehowah figuratively sifts through or **lifts** up the islands through his fingers as mere fine dust.
- Look! The nations are as a drop from a bucket, and as the film of dust on the scales they have been accounted. Look! He **lifts** the islands themselves as mere fine dust. (Isaiah 40:15)
- The Man Of Lawlessness **lifts** himself up over everyone who is called god, or an object of reverence.
- He is set in opposition and **lifts** himself up over everyone who is called god or an object of reverence, so that he sits down in the temple of The God, publicly showing himself to be a god. (2 Thessalonians 2:4)
