[English, raises, picks up, hauls up, elevates, boosts]

- Yehowah from the ashpit lifts up the poor and lowly ones.
- A Raiser of a lowly one from the dust, from the ashpit he lifts up a poor one, to make them sit with nobles, and a throne of glory he gives to them as a possession. For to Yehowah belong earth's supports, and he places upon them the productive land. (1 Samuel 2:8)
- Yehowah causes a tempestuous wind to lift up the ocean's waves.
- How he says the word and causes a tempestuous wind to arise, so that it lifts up its waves. (Psalms 107:25)
- Yehowah figuratively sifts through or lifts up the islands through his fingers as mere fine dust.
- Look! The nations are as a drop from a bucket, and as the film of dust on the scales they have been accounted. Look! He lifts the islands themselves as mere fine dust. (Isaiah 40:15)
- The Man Of Lawlessness lifts himself up over everyone who is called god, or an object of reverence.
- He is set in opposition and lifts himself up over everyone who is called god or an object of reverence, so that he sits down in the temple of The God, publicly showing himself to be a god. (2 Thessalonians 2:4)
