[English, probably, possible, expected, to be expected, Opposite of, unlikely]

- Joshua felt that **likely** Yehowah would be with him as promised and he would dispossess them from the land.
- And now do give me this mountainous region that Yehowah promised on that day, for you yourself heard on that day that there were Anakim there and great fortified cities. **Likely** Yehowah will be with me, and I shall certainly dispossess them, just as Yehowah promised. (**Joshua 14:12**)
- The second coming of the Christ is to take place at a time that true Christians do not think **likely**.
- You also, keep ready, because at an hour that you do not think **likely** the Son of man is coming. (**Luke 12:40**)
- The vineyard owner thought about the cultivators of the vineyard that **likely** they would respect his one son.
