- Really what **likeness** could any man assign to God who is spirit and unseen. With what could man **liken** or compare God to.
- And to whom can you people **liken** God, and what likeness can you put alongside him? (**Isaiah 40:18**)
- But to whom can you people **liken** me so that I should be made his equal? Says the Holy One. (**Isaiah 40:25**)
- To whom will you people **liken** me or make me equal or compare me that we may resemble each other? (**Isaiah 46:5**)
- Jeremiah could not find anything with which to **liken** Jerusalem except the great wide sea.
- Of what shall I use you as a witness? What shall I **liken** to you, O daughter of Jerusalem? What shall I make equal to you, that I may comfort you, O virgin daughter of Zion? For your breakdown is just as great as the sea. Who can bring healing to you? (**Lamentations 2:13**)
- Jesus set out many Kingdom illustrations **likening** them to the Kingdom of God.
- And he went on to say; With what are we to **liken** the kingdom of God, or in what illustration shall we set it out? (**Mark 4:30**)
