- The Israelites felt that Moses was playing the prince over his people to the limit.
- Is it so little a thing that you have brought us up out of a land flowing with milk and honey to put us to death in the wilderness, that you should also try to play the prince over us to the limit? (Numbers 16:13)
- Balak chastised Balaam for blessing Israel to the limit, instead of cursing them.
- At this Balak said to Balaam; What have you done to me? It was in order to execrate my enemies that I took you, and here you have blessed them to the limit. (Numbers 23:11)
- At that Balak's anger blazed against Balaam and he clapped his hands, and Balak went on to say to Balaam; It was to execrate my enemies that I called you, and, look! You have blessed them to the limit these three times. (Numbers 24:10)
- · Artaxerxes the king, ordered for supplies to be granted to Ezra, and among them, salt without limit.
- Even to a hundred talents of silver and a hundred cor measures of wheat and a hundred bath measures of wine and a hundred bath measures of oil, and salt without limit. (Ezra 7:22)
- Ezra showed, that Yehowah God had reached the limit of his patience, and become incensed with his people sending them into exile.
- Shall we go breaking your commandments again and forming marriage alliances with the peoples of these detestable things? Will you not get incensed at us to the limit so that there will be none remaining and none escaping? (Ezra 9:14)
- Job was asked if he could fathom the limits of his God.
- Can you find out the deep things of God, or can you find out to

the very limit of the Almighty? (Job 11:7)

- Job asked Yehowah God to set a time limit for him and to remember him through a resurrection.
- O that in Sheol you would conceal me, that you would keep me secret until your anger turns back, that you would set a time limit for me and remember me! (Job 14:13)
- Job was asked if he limited wisdom to his own self.
- To the confidential talk of God do you listen, and do you limit wisdom to yourself? (Job 15:8)
- Yehowah God is the one setting every limit.
- An end to the darkness he has set, and to every limit he is searching out stone in the gloom and deep shadow. (Job 28:3)
- They have become a materialistic pleasure-seeking people and their wealth multiplies beyond limits, but their God and his fine spiritual values they ignore. They have become mighty militarily, having many horses and chariots, but to Yehowah their God, they do not look for help nor trust in him.
- And their land is filled with silver and gold, and there is no limit to their treasures. And their land is filled with horses, and there is no limit to their chariots. (Isaiah 2:7)
- They have thus become intoxicated with this power, that they exercise over other men, who are willing to worship them. As with strong drink, they simply do not sense when to limit themselves. They think, that their organization's growth will continue on, each day, like the last one, forever. They think, that they will continue to grow very much greater in a larger way. They worship growth, and they feel that their growth will continue on forever, but they are spiritually drunk to the real situation.
- Come, men! Let me take some wine, and let us drink intoxicating liquor to the limit. And tomorrow will certainly turn out just as today, great in a very much larger way. (Isaiah 56:12)

- The conquerors then cry out to plunder silver and gold within her walls, as she is a very rich city, for within her is a very heavy amount of desirable articles, without limit.
- Plunder silver, you men, plunder gold. As there is no limit to the things in arrangement. There is a heavy amount of all sorts of desirable articles. (Nahum 2:9)
- Then Ethiopia was a confederate of Egypt, and they had support from them without limit. Also Put and the Libyans themselves proved to be of assistance to you.
- Ethiopia was her full might, also Egypt, and that without limit.
 Put and the Libyans themselves proved to be of assistance to you. (Nahum 3:9)
- But when the full limit of the appointed times arrived, God sent forth his Son, who came to be born to a woman, and who was born to a people under the Law Covenant of Moses.
- But when the full limit of the time arrived, God sent forth his Son, who came to be out of a woman and who came to be under law. (Galatians 4:4)
- This purpose of God, is for an administration, at the full limit of the appointed times, which will gather together again in the Christ, all things in heaven and on the earth, yes in Christ Jesus. This administration will manage all of God's household of creatures both in heaven and on the earth.
- For an administration at the full limit of the appointed times, namely, to gather all things together again in the Christ, the things in the heavens and the things on the earth. Yes, in him. (Ephesians 1:10)
- It was by faith, that Sarah herself received power to conceive a seed when she was ninety years old and well past menstruation. She esteemed Yehowah God faithful to his promise, and so did not doubt his ability to bring it about.
- Sarah represents the heavenly angelic organization of Yehowah God, led by his foremost son Jesus Christ. They are the heavenly mother of spirit anointed Christians, and they exercised faith in God's plan for the seed.

By faith also Sarah herself received power to conceive seed, even when she was past the age limit, since she esteemed him faithful who had promised. (Hebrews 11:11)
