~LIMPING (100)

[English, hobbling, shuffling, walking lamely, shambling]

- Jacob was limping upon his thigh, because of the angel who touched him.
- And the sun began to flash upon him as soon as he passed by Penuel, but he was limping upon his thigh. (Genesis 32:31)
- Elijah asked the people of Israel how long they would continue limping upon two different opinions, as to who was the true God, and who was false.
- Then Elijah approached all the people and said; How long will you be limping upon two different opinions? If Yehowah is the true God, go following him, but if Baal is, go following him. And the people did not say a word in answer to him. (1 Kings 18:21)
- Accordingly they took the young bull that he gave them. Then they dressed it, and they kept calling upon the name of Baal from morning till noon, saying; O Baal, answer us! But there was no voice, and there was no one answering. And they kept limping around the altar that they had made. (1 Kings 18:26)
- The Psalmist prophetically prophesies about the Messiah and how men would treat him, when they saw him limping figuratively.
- But at my limping they rejoiced and gathered together, they gathered together against me, striking me down when I did not know it, they ripped me to pieces and did not keep silent. (Psalms 35:15)
- Jeremiah's situation was perilous, for there was fright all around Jerusalem and within her men were wishing him well, but at the same time watching for his limping or for a weakness to destroy him.
- For I heard the bad report of many. There was fright all around. tell out, that we may tell out about him. Every mortal man bidding me; Peace! They are watching for my limping. Perhaps he will be fooled, so that we may prevail against him and take our revenge upon him. (Jeremiah 20:10)

- Then in that day, Yehowah God will stretch out his arm of compassion upon the peoples who are limping, and needing his assistance, as he did in the First Century C.E. under his Son, Jesus Christ. Also upon those who were scattered, by the tribulation he brought against false religion, them he will collect together, even the ones he had treated badly, due to their error and sinfulness.
- In that day, is the utterance of Yehowah, I will gather her that was limping, and her that was dispersed I will collect together, even her whom I have treated badly. (Micah 4:6)
- Also then his spiritual sons that are limping to righteousness, a remnant of them, and the other worshipers who were removed far off from true worship, like the Catholic Church and all of Christendom, Yehowah will then make them into a mighty nation. Then Yehowah God will rule over all of them in Mount Zion, his ruling authority made up of Christ and his 144,000 spirit anointed sons, from now on and to time indefinite.
- And I shall certainly make her that was limping a remnant, and her that was removed far off a mighty nation, and Yehowah will actually rule as king over them in Mount Zion, from now on and into time indefinite. (Micah 4:7)
- At that time Yehowah God will also act against all of those afflicting Jerusalem. Then also, he will act in behalf of those who are limping among her, and also the dispersed ones, and he shall then collect them all together. Then he will set them as a praise and as a name, or fine reputation, in the same land that once became their shame, the Promised Land.
- Here I am acting against all those afflicting you, at that time, and I will save her that is limping, and her that is dispersed I shall collect together. And I will set them as a praise and as a name in all the land of their shame. (Zephaniah 3:19)
