

## ~LINGER (22)

[English, remain, stay behind, hang back, delay leaving, hang on, hang around, loiter, Opposite of, **leave**]

- Because the exodus from Egypt came suddenly they were not able to **linger** and prepare provisions for themselves.
- And they began to bake the flour dough that they had brought out from Egypt into round cakes, unfermented cakes, because it had not leavened, for they had been driven out of Egypt and had not been able to **linger** and too they had not prepared any provisions for themselves. (**Exodus 12:39**)
- The crowd of nation rising up against Zion are told to **linger** in the spiritual drunkenness and become intoxicated.
- **Linger**, you men, and be amazed. Blind yourselves, and be blinded. They have become intoxicated, but not with wine. They have moved unsteadily, but not because of intoxicating liquor. (**Isaiah 29:9**)
