~LINUS (15) (Li'nus)

- A Christian in Rome named by the apostle Paul as sending greetings to Timothy.
- Do your utmost to arrive before winter. Eubulus sends you his greetings, and so do Pudens and Linus and Claudia and all the brothers. (2 Timothy 4:21)
- Irenaeus born about 130 C.E. and others after him have identified this Linus with an early overseer of Rome who bore the same name, but this identification rests merely on tradition.
