

**~LO-DEBAR (29)**  
**(Lo-de'bar)**

- The site where Machir, a contemporary of King David, had his home.
- Then the king said to him; Where is he? So Ziba said to the king; Look! He is in the house of Machir the son of Ammiel at **Lo-debar**. (2 Samuel 9:4)
- Immediately King David sent and took him from the house of Machir the son of Ammiel at **Lo-debar**. (2 Samuel 9:5)
- And it came about that, as soon as David came to Mahanaim, Shobi the son of Nahash from Rabbah of the sons of Ammon, and Machir the son of Ammiel from **Lo-debar**, and Barzillai the Gileadite from Rogelim. (2 Samuel 17:27)
- **Lo-debar** is usually thought to be the same as **Debir** in Gad.
- Furthermore, Moses made a gift to the tribe of Gad, the sons of Gad by their families. (Joshua 13:24)
- And from Heshbon to Ramath-mizpeh and Betonim and from Mahanaim to the border of **Debir**. (Joshua 13:26)
