~LOATHING (124)

[English, hate, hatred, dislike, repugnance, detestation, abhorrence, disgust, aversion revulsion, Opposite of, love]

- Yehowah God promised that the meat Israel would eat would become a **loathing** to them before they finished eating it all.
- But up to a month of days, until it comes out of your nostrils and it has become a loathing to you, just because you rejected Yehowah, who is in your midst, and you went weeping before him, saying; Why is it that we have come out of Egypt? (Numbers 11:20)
- Job showed that in his stressful situation his life was a loathing to him.
- My soul certainly feels a **loathing** toward my life. I will give vent to my concern about myself. I will speak in the bitterness of my soul! (Job 10:1)
- The Psalmist showed that for forty years Yehowah God felt a loathing toward the Israelites, that had rebelled against him in the wilderness.
- For forty years I kept feeling a loathing toward that generation, and I proceeded to say; They are a people wayward at heart, and they themselves have not come to know my ways. (Psalms 95:10)
- The Psalmist felt a loathing toward those who were treacherous in their dealings.
- I have seen those who are treacherous in dealing, and I do feel a loathing, because they have not kept your own saying; (Psalms 119:158)
- Also the Psalmist felt a **loathing** toward those intensely hating Yehowah God and revolting against him.
- Do I not hate those who are intensely hating you, O Yehowah, and do I not feel a loathing for those revolting against you? (Psalms 139:21)

- When these escaped ones look back and remember how good true worship can be, then they will remember Yehowah's true way to the nations. The Preaching of the Good News of the Kingdom is not all that matters to Yehowah God as most of Jehovah's Witnesses presently think. Yehowah is gathering a people for his name's sake. They must be like him in all that they do and really measure up to his divine principles in all of their works.
- To practice injustice, oppression, or lack of respect for truth, is spiritual fornication, harlotry. To worship men is to worship dungy idols that cannot save or destroy. Only then will they awake and come to their senses and feel a loathing, and repent of these practices.
- And your escaped ones will certainly remember me among the nations to which they will have been taken captive, because I have been broken up at their fornicating heart that has turned aside from me and at their eyes that are going in fornication after their dungy idols, and they will certainly feel a loathing in their faces at the bad things that they have done in all their detestable things. (Ezekiel 6:9)
- After being completely rejected by Yehowah and scattered among the nations many will turn back to Yehowah. They will realize the glorification of men and the praising of their own organization, the not listening to their God, were the very things that brought their ruin. When they realize that these practices made them destroy anointed sons of God and reject the Messiah then they will actually feel a loathing over themselves and the bad things that they did.
- And you will certainly remember there your ways and all your dealings by which you defiled yourselves, and you will actually feel a loathing at your own faces because of all your bad things that you did. (Ezekiel 20:43)
- Jehovah's Witnesses will then call back to mind their treatment of newly anointed ones, rejection of the Son of Man, rejection of insight from Yehowah and what it all led to for them. They will feel a loathing of themselves for kissing up to mere dungy idols and rejecting of truth. They will know that they have no one to blame but themselves for practicing these things.
- And you will be bound to remember your bad ways and your dealings that were not good, and you will be bound to feel a

loathing at your own person on account of your errors and on account of your detestable things. (Ezekiel 36:31)

- Then Yehowah God effaced three of these wicked shepherds in one month, because his soul had become impatient with them over time, and also, because they felt a **loathing** for him, their God.
- And I finally effaced three shepherds in one lunar month, as my soul gradually became impatient with them, and also their own soul felt a loathing toward me. (Zechariah 11:8)
