~LOATHSOME (115)

[English, hateful, despicable, disgusting, repugnant, detestable, abhorrent, obnoxious, Opposite of, delightful]

- Any man touching a loathsome thing and then sharing in a communion meal was to be cut off.
- And in case a soul touches anything unclean, the uncleanness of a man or an unclean beast or any unclean loathsome thing, and actually eats some of the flesh of the communion sacrifice, which is for Yehowah, that soul must be cut off from his people. (Leviticus 7:21)
- Anything growing in the oceans without fins or scales was a loathsome thing, not to be eaten by Israelites.
- And everything in the seas and the torrents that has no fins and scales, out of every swarming creature of the waters and out of every living soul that is in the waters, they are a loathsome thing for you. (Leviticus 11:10)
- Yes, they will become a loathsome thing to you. You must not eat any of their flesh, and you are to loathe their dead body. (Leviticus 11:11)
- Everything in the waters that has no fins and scales is a loathsome thing to you. (Leviticus 11:12)
- · Also many birds were classified as loathsome things, mostly birds of prey.
- And these are what you will loathe among the flying creatures. They should not be eaten. They are a loathsome thing: the eagle and the osprey and the black vulture. (Leviticus 11:13)
- · Also many swarming creatures, and those crawling upon the earth.
- Every winged swarming creature that goes on all fours is a loathsome thing to you. (Leviticus 11:20)
- And every other winged swarming creature that does have four

legs is a loathsome thing to you. (Leviticus 11:23)

- And every swarming creature that swarms upon the earth is a loathsome thing. It must not be eaten. (Leviticus 11:41)
- As for any creature that goes upon the belly and any creature that goes on all fours or any great number of feet of all the swarming creatures that swarm upon the earth, you must not eat them, because they are a loathsome thing. (Leviticus 11:42)
- Do not make your souls **loathsome** with any swarming creature that swarms, and you must not make yourselves unclean by them and actually get unclean by them. (Leviticus 11:43)
- And you must make a distinction between the clean beast and the unclean and between the unclean fowl and the clean, and you must not make your souls loathsome with the beast and the fowl and anything that moves on the ground that I have divided off for you in declaring them unclean. (Leviticus 20:25)
- Job showed that his breath had become **loathsome** to his wife, and his own brothers considered him foul smelling.
- My breath itself has become loathsome to my wife, and I have become foul-smelling to the sons of my mother's belly. (Job 19:17)
- Yehowah's day will come in against all of those who practice false religion, worship idols, and who ignore all of Yehowah's requirements and guidelines for life. They will become ashamed of the big trees, their religious leaders who have led them to destruction.
- Those sanctifying themselves and cleansing themselves for the gardens behind one in the center, eating the flesh of the pig and the loathsome thing, even the jumping rodent, they will all together reach their end, is the utterance of Yehowah. (Isaiah 66:17)
- Jehovah's Witnesses say that they are a clean people, but they make people worship idols in their minds. They worship their beastlike Governing Body, by saying, that only what they teach is the truth. They worship their own organization by comparing its size and strength to worldly nations.

- They idolize men by putting the ideas of a few above all others. They worship prominence and titles. These disgusting and loathsome things are like carvings on their walls, because they surround themselves with them and they are now deeply ingrained in their way of worship like a carving. They also worship the Baal, of growth as their Master.
- So I went in and began to see, and, look! There was every representation of creeping things and loathsome beasts, and all the dungy idols of the house of Israel, the carving being upon the wall all round about. (Ezekiel 8:10)
