~LOOKOUT (41)

[English, guard, sentry, watch, sentinel]

- The wicked one is always on the **lookout** to harm someone unfortunate.
- He sits in an ambush of settlements, from concealed places he will kill someone innocent. His eyes are on the lookout for someone unfortunate. (Psalms 10:8)
- The daughter of Zion, referring to those left remaining in her who truly loved justice and righteousness, was like a lookout hut in a field of cucumbers, there within Jerusalem before her fall.
- And the daughter of Zion has been left remaining like a booth in a vineyard, like a lookout hut in a field of cucumbers, like a blockaded city. (Isaiah 1:8)
- Prophetically Babylon is told to post a **lookout** for Elam and Media are to rise up against her.
- For this is what Yehowah has said to me; Go, post a lookout that he may tell just what he sees. (Isaiah 21:6)
- The land of Israel before its fall was like an unstable lookout hut for she no longer was strengthened by the righteous principle of this God.
- The land absolutely moves unsteadily like a drunken man, and it has swayed to and fro like a lookout hut. And its transgression has become heavy upon it, and it must fall, so that it will not rise up again. (Isaiah 24:20)
- Micah shows that he would keep on the **lookout** for his God of salvation, showing a waiting attitude.
- But as for me, it is for Yehowah that I shall keep on the lookout. I will show a waiting attitude for the God of my salvation. My God will hear me. (Micah 7:7)
