

~LOOSING (32)

[English, untying, undoing, releasing, relaxing, slackening, slackening off, Opposite of, **tightening**]

- Jesus disciples were asked why they were **loosing** the colt.
- But some of those standing there began to say to them; What are you doing **loosing** the colt? (**Mark 11:5**)
- But if anyone asks you; Why is it you are **loosing** it? You must speak in this way; The Lord needs it. (**Luke 19:31**)
- But as they were **loosing** the colt the owners of it said to them; Why are you losing the colt? (**Luke 19:33**)
- Peter testifies that God loosed Jesus from the pangs of death by a resurrection because he could not be held fast by it.
- But God resurrected him by **loosing** the pangs of death, because it was not possible for him to continue to be held fast by it. (**Acts of Apostles 2:24**)
- When shipwrecked on Malta, Paul and his companions **loosed** the lashings of the rudder oars and made for the beach to avoid catastrophe.
- So, cutting away the anchors, they let them fall into the sea, at the same time **loosing** the lashings of the rudder oars and, after hoisting the foresail to the wind, they made for the beach. (**Acts of Apostles 27:40**)
