## ~LOSE (96)

[English, misplace, be unable to find, mislay, drop, Opposite of, find]

- Thus, he that lost his soul for the Lord's sake would find it eternally. Yet those rejecting the Good News and remaining in their sins like all others on earth do, would lose their souls, remaining in their sins.
- He that finds his soul will lose it, and he that loses his soul for my sake will find it. (Matthew 10:39)
- Jesus then showed, that persons who would do so small a favor to one of his disciples who was charged with preaching the Good News of God, as offering them a drink of water for their thirst, would by no means lose his reward for doing this smallest kindness. So then acts of kindness and favor toward Christ's anointed disciples would be the basis for judgment of many.
- And whoever gives one of these little ones only a cup of cold water to drink because he is a disciple, I tell you truly, he will by no means lose his reward. (Matthew 10:42)
- Jesus then showed, that those who try to preserve their lives at the expense of their integrity, will lose both. However whoever keeps his integrity like Christ did, will find everlasting life through him.
- For whoever wants to save his soul will lose it, but whoever loses his soul for my sake will find it. (Matthew 16:25)
- Jesus then showed, that whoever tried to save his own soul, would lose it. Yet those who gave up their own self-willed course to follow after him, and for the sake of the Good News, giving of themselves even unto death like he did, would gain their souls.
- For whoever wants to save his soul will lose it, but whoever loses his soul for the sake of me and the Good News will save it. (Mark 8:35)
- Jesus then showed, that people who work along with Jesus Christ and his disciples in the work that they are doing, even in something as insignificant as giving them a drink of water, would by no

means lose their reward, for Yehowah God would bless anyone helping them.

- For whoever gives you a cup of water to drink on the ground that you belong to Christ, I truly tell you, he will by no means lose his reward. (Mark 9:41)
- Jesus then told his disciples, that anyone who would try to save his soul in this life, would lose it, and whoever would willingly lose his soul in this life for his sake, is the one that will save it eternally.
- For whoever wants to save his soul will lose it, but whoever loses his soul for my sake is the one that will save it. (Luke 9:24)
- Then Jesus showed, that whoever tried to save his soul would lose it, but that whoever loses it, would preserve it alive.
- Whoever seeks to keep his soul safe for himself will lose it, but whoever loses it will preserve it alive. (Luke 17:33)
- Then Jesus showed, that the will of his heavenly Father, was that he should lose nothing out of all the things that have been granted to him, but that on the last day he should resurrect such ones to life again.
- This is the will of him that sent me, that I should lose nothing out of all that he has given me but that I should resurrect it at the last day. (John 6:39)
- John now counsels them to not lose the things that they have worked hard to produce, so that they will attain to a full reward for their faithfulness. Believing in lies and deceptions would take them out of the favor of Yehowah God, who is a God of truth.
- Look out for yourselves, that you do not lose the things we have worked to produce, but that you may obtain a full reward. (2 John 1:8)
