~LOVING-KINDNESSES (75)

[English, Acts of loyal love, acts of kindness due to loyalty]

- In his prayer Solomon asked Yehowah God to remember the loving-kindnesses made to David his father.
- O Yehowah God, do not turn back the face of your anointed one. O do remember the loving-kindnesses to David your servant. (2 Chronicles 6:42)
- The Psalmist asked Yehowah God to make his acts of loving-kindnesses wonderful toward his faithful people.
- Make your acts of loving-kindnesses wonderful, O Savior of those seeking refuge from the revolters against your right hand. (Psalms 17:7)
- The Psalmist asked Yehowah God to remember his loving-kindnesses, for they are to time indefinite.
- Remember your mercies, O Yehowah, and your loving-kindnesses, for they are from time indefinite. (Psalms 25:6)
- The Psalmist asked that the **loving-kindnesses** of Yehowah God would come to him, and his salvation according to his earlier promise.
- And may your loving-kindnesses come to me, O Yehowah, your salvation according to your saying; (Psalms 119:41)
- Develop within yourself an inclination to search for truth. Listen to God, and all that he teaches, for it means life for you.
- Incline your ear and come to me. Listen, and your soul will keep alive, and I shall readily conclude with you people an indefinitely lasting covenant respecting the loving-kindnesses to David that are faithful. (Isaiah 55:3)
- This God of vengeance who brings men and nations to ruin as in a winepress, is not the character of their God, that they have known for centuries, for there is a limit to even his great patience. He has always been a God of loving-kindnesses, one looking for ways to help and bless his people. Despite his current rage against them, he is to be

praised for his abundant mercies, goodness and loving-kindnesses rendered over many centuries.

- The loving-kindnesses of Yehowah I shall mention, the praises of Yehowah, according to all that Yehowah has rendered to us, even the abundant goodness to the house of Israel that he has rendered to them according to his mercies and according to the abundance of his loving-kindnesses. (Isaiah 63:7)
- Paul then showed, that Yehowah God raised him from the dead, and that no more was he destined to see corruption, just as Yehowah God had prophetically stated through David, that he would give to David the loving-kindnesses that were faithful, he had now fulfilled his promise to David, by bringing forth this one.
- And that fact that he resurrected him from the dead destined no more to return to corruption, he has stated in this way, I will give you people the loving-kindnesses to David that are faithful. (Acts of Apostles 13:34)
