- A Christian relative of Paul who was with him in Corinth during his third missionary tour when the apostle wrote his letter to the Romans. Lucius joined in sending greetings to Christians in Rome.
- Timothy my fellow worker greets you, and so do Lucius and Jason and Sosipater my relatives. (Romans 16:21)
