[English, opulently, richly, luxuriously, splendidly, ornately, handsomely, abundantly, Opposite of, poorly]

- Sampson's hair grew **luxuriantly** as soon as it had been shaved.
- Meanwhile the hair of his head started to grow **luxuriantly** as soon as he had been shaved. (**Judges 16:22**)
- Before his day will it be fulfilled. and his shoot itself will certainly not grow **luxuriantly**. (**Job 15:32**)
- Yehowah shows how his feeding of his people, Judah, caused them to become firmly developed with **luxuriant** hair.
- A very big multitude like the sprouting of the field is what I made you so that you would grow big and become great and come in with the finest ornament. The two breasts themselves were firmly developed, and your own hair grew **luxuriantly**, when you had been naked and nude. (**Ezekiel 16:7**)
- Yehowah showed that his people in exile in Babylon would become a **luxuriantly** growing vine turning its foliage inward.
- And it began to sprout and gradually became a **luxuriantly** growing vine low in height, inclined to turn its foliage inward, and as for its roots, they gradually came to be under it. And it finally became a vine and produced shoots and sent forth branches. (**Ezekiel 17:6**)
