~LYDDA (38) (Lyd'da)

- Lydda is identified with el-Ludd, modern Lod, in the Plain of Sharon about 18 kilometers (11 miles) Southeast of Joppa. At Lydda, Peter healed paralyzed Aeneas. This miracle caused many in the vicinity to accept Christianity.
- Now as Peter was going through all parts he came down also to the holy ones that dwelt in Lydda. (Acts of Apostles 9:32)
- There he found a certain man named Aeneas, who had been lying flat on his cot for eight years, as he was paralyzed. (Acts of Apostles 9:33)
- And Peter said to him; Aeneas, Jesus Christ heals you. Rise and make up your bed. And he rose immediately. (Acts of Apostles 9:34)
- And all those who inhabited Lydda and the plain of Sharon saw him, and these turned to the Lord. (Acts of Apostles 9:35)
- Now as Lydda was near Joppa, when the disciples heard that Peter was in this city they dispatched two men to him to entreat him; Please do not hesitate to come on as far as us. (Acts of Apostles 9:38)
- Lydda is considered to be the same as Lod.
- And the sons of Elpaal were Eber and Misham and Shemed, who built Ono and Lod and its dependent towns. (1 Chronicles 8:12)
