~MAADAI (17)

(Ma-a-da'i) [shortened form of Maadiah]

- An Israelite among the sons of Bani who had accepted foreign wives but sent them away in Ezra's day after the Jews returned from Babylonian exile.
- And of Israel, of the sons of Parosh there were Ramiah and Izziah and Malchijah and Mijamin and Eleazar and Malchijah and Benaiah. (Ezra 10:25)
- Of the sons of Bani, Maadai, Amram and Uel. (Ezra 10:34)
- These all had accepted foreign wives, and they proceeded to send away wives along with sons. (Ezra 10:44)
