~MAGBISH (18) (Mag'bish)

- The name of either a person or a place. Among those returning from Babylonian exile were 156 sons of Magbish.
- And these were the sons of the jurisdictional district that went up out of the captivity of the exiled people whom Nebuchadnezzar the king of Babylon had taken into exile at Babylon and who later returned to Jerusalem and Judah, each one to his own city. (Ezra 2:1)
- The sons of Magbish, a hundred and fifty-six. (Ezra 2:30)
- Some tentatively identify Magbish with Khirbet el-Mahbiyeh, located about 5 kilometers (3 miles) Southwest of Adullam.
