## ~MAGNIFY (100)

[English, enlarge, blow up, expand, amplify, increase, Opposite of, shrink]

- Man should remember to magnify the activity of Yehowah God and sing his praises.
- Remember that you should magnify his activity of which men have sung. (Job 36:24)
- O magnify Yehowah with me, you people, and let us exalt his name together. (Psalms 34:3)
- I will praise the name of God with song, and I will magnify him with thanksgiving. (Psalms 69:30)
- Like the ax, the Assyrian's were the instrument God would use to discipline Israel, and the ax today, is the United Nations, which will chop down all of the religious trees. However, Yehowah is the one who is making this happen. Does a saw cut down trees by itself, or does a man have to push it back and forth, to make it accomplish his will?
- Will the ax enhance itself over the one chopping with it, or the saw magnify itself over the one moving it back and forth, as though the staff moved back and forth the ones raising it on high, as though the rod raised on high the one who is not wood? (Isaiah 10:15)
- Yehowah himself, a spiritual being, takes delight in magnifying the Law and making it majestic. He wants his people to be spiritual like him and take delight in learning the laws and principles of his word and his way. He wants them to glorify this work, making it majestic, something all people will put on high.
- Yehowah himself for the sake of his righteousness has taken a delight in that he should magnify the Law and make it majestic. (Isaiah 42:21)
- The nations of all the earth are as mere dust when compared to Yehowah the creator of the entire universe. Yet they have tried to lord it over him and to carry on their way despite his repeated counsels. Once he has logically, reasonably and by sound evidence proved the

rightfulness of his way, he will magnify his great name by destroying all opposers to peace. He will sanctify his great name by fulfilling every promise found in his word the Bible.

- And I shall certainly magnify myself and sanctify myself and make myself known before the eyes of many nations, and they will have to know that I am Yehowah. (Ezekiel 38:23)
- The Governing Body of Jehovah's Witnesses have themselves taken on the power of kings over God's people today, and they magnify themselves above every other anointed one saying, that only what they teach is truth.
- They have acted against the God of gods by disfellowshipping God's son the Son of Man and removing other anointed ones from their midst. They customarily reject every form of new understanding sent to them, and will not listen to their God on any matter.
- They have what seems to them like success for their organization is growing in leaps and bounds today, yet this success will only last until the denunciation will have come to a finish.
- And the king will actually do according to his own will, and he will exalt himself and magnify himself above every god, and against the God of gods he will speak marvelous things. And he will certainly prove successful until the denunciation will have come to a finish, because the thing decided upon must be done. (Daniel 11:36)
- These old men of the Governing Body have magnified themselves up over everyone, and they give no consideration to the words or thoughts of anyone else. They magnify their own thoughts and ideas over everyone, and call all others apostates. Most of them are older single men.
- And to the God of his fathers he will give no consideration, and to the desire of women and to every other god he will give no consideration, but over everyone he will magnify himself. (Daniel 11:37)
