· Probably a musical term, perhaps one of a technical nature, found in the superscriptions of (**Psalms Chapters 53, 88**) Some believe that this term may be related to a **Hebrew** root verb meaning, **grow weak, fall sick**, thereby suggesting a gloomy and melancholy tune. This would harmonize with the somewhat somber content of the two songs, particularly that of (**Psalms Chapter 88**)
