~MAHOL (21)

(Ma'hol) [from a root meaning, dance, whirl, or, possibly from a root Meaning, play the flute]

- One whose sons wisdom, though great, was not equal to King Solomon's.
- And he was wiser than any other man, than Ethan the Ezrahite and Heman and Calcol and Darda the sons of Mahol, and his fame came to be in all the nations all around. (1 Kings 4:31)
- Some view the designation sons of Mahol to mean an association of musicians or dancers.
- Praise him with the tambourine and the circle dance. Praise him with strings and the pipe. (Psalms 150:4)
- Where the same Hebrew word is rendered, circle dance.
