

~MAHOL (21)

(Ma'hol) [from a root meaning, dance, whirl, or, possibly from a root Meaning, play the flute]

- **One whose sons wisdom, though great, was not equal to King Solomon's.**
- **And he was wiser than any other man, than Ethan the Ezrahite and Heman and Calcol and Darda the sons of **Mahol**, and his fame came to be in all the nations all around. (**1 Kings 4:31**)**
- **Some view the designation **sons of Mahol** to mean an association of musicians or dancers.**
- **Praise him with the tambourine and the circle dance. Praise him with strings and the pipe. (**Psalms 150:4**)**
- **Where the same **Hebrew** word is rendered, **circle dance**.**
