[English, regal, royal, grand, stately, imposing, grandiose, magnificent, superb, splendid, Opposite of, humble]

- Moses showed how the Egyptians sank like lead in the majestic waters when the Red Sea covered them over.
- You blew with your breath, the sea covered them, they sank like lead in majestic waters. (Exodus 15:10)
- Deborah showed that Yehowah God's majestic people, the angels assisted in the fight against Sisera.
- It was then the survivors came down to the majestic ones, Yehowah's people came down to me against the mighty ones. (Judges 5:13)
- Jael presented curdled milk which put Sisera to sleep in the banquet bowl of majestic ones, she presented it.
- Water he asked, milk she gave, In the large banquet bowl of majestic ones she presented curdled milk. (Judges 5:25)
- The Philistines became afraid, and asked who could save them from this majestic God, Yehowah.
- Woe to us! Who will save us from the hand of this majestic God? This is the God that was the smiter of Egypt with every sort of slaughter in the wilderness. (1 Samuel 4:8)
- The majestic ones of the people did not join in the actual work of rebuilding the wall of Jerusalem.
- And at their side the Tekoites did repair work, but their majestic ones themselves did not bring the back of their neck into the service of their masters. (Nehemiah 3:5)
- The majestic ones among the people were instructing them in Yehowah God's Law Covenant.
- They were adhering to their brothers, their majestic ones, and coming into liability to a curse and into an oath, to walk in the

Law of the true God, which had been given by the hand of Moses the servant of the true God, and to keep and to perform all the commandments of Yehowah our Lord and his judicial decisions and his regulations. (Nehemiah 10:29)

- Job showed that the depths of the earth are a place where no majestic wild beast has trodden.
- The majestic wild beasts have not trodden it down solid, the young lion has not paced over it. (Job 28:8)
- Job shows that Leviathan is a king among all majestic wild beasts.
- Everything high it sees. It is king over all majestic wild beasts. (Job 41:34)
- The name of Yehowah God is majestic in all the earth, and his dignity is recounted in the heavens.
- O Yehowah our Lord, how majestic your name is in all the earth, you whose dignity is recounted above the heavens! (Psalms 8:1)
- O Yehowah our Lord, how majestic your name is in all the earth! (Psalms 8:9)
- The Psalmist showed that his delight was in the majestic ones of the earth, Yehowah God's anointed sons.
- But to the holy ones that are in the earth. They, even the majestic ones, are the ones in whom is all my delight. (Psalms 16:3)
- The Psalmist showed, that Yehowah God is enveloped in light, and is more majestic than the mountains of prey.
- You are enveloped with light, more majestic than the mountains of prey. (Psalms 76:4)
- Yehowah God is majestic even above the majesty of the waves of the sea, Yehowah God is majestic in the heights.
- Above the sounds of vast waters, the majestic breaking waves of the sea, Yehowah is majestic in the height. (Psalms 93:4)

- Yehowah God proceeded to kill even majestic kings.
- And who proceeded to kill majestic kings. For his loving-kindness is to time indefinite. (Psalms 136:18)
- There the Majestic One Yehowah will be like a river or a wide canal, from whom come waters of truth in abundance. Only Yehowah and no foreign power will control these waters of truth.
- But there the Majestic One, Yehowah, will be for us a place of rivers, of wide canals. On it no galley fleet will go, and no majestic ship will pass over it. (Isaiah 33:21)
- Yehowah himself, a spiritual being, takes delight in magnifying the Law and making it majestic. He wants his people to be spiritual like him and take delight in learning the laws and principles of his word and his way. He wants them to glorify this work, making it majestic, something all people will put on high.
- Yehowah himself for the sake of his righteousness has taken a delight in that he should magnify the Law and make it majestic. (Isaiah 42:21)
- The Governing Body of Jehovah's Witnesses, their majestic ones, are all anointed ones, but they have non-anointed ones who do the real work of running the organization, because the others are quite old. These non-anointed men have been charged since 1992 C.E, with providing the organization with spiritual food. However, they have found that the ditches are empty, there is no new spiritual food or understanding, there is no water!
- And their majestic ones themselves have sent their insignificant ones for water. They have come to the ditches. They have found no water. They have returned with their vessels empty. They have been put to shame and have been disappointed, and they have covered their head. (Jeremiah 14:3)
- Yes, howl you shepherds and you majestic ones of the flock, who have misled their flocks saying; Peace! There is Peace! When there is no peace, between them and their God, for your days of slaughtering will come, and all of your flocks will be scattered.

- Like a desirable vessel, that falls suddenly and cannot be caught, they will fall suddenly and be shattered to pieces. The day of Yehowah's accounting with all of the false shepherds has arrived.
- Howl, you shepherds, and cry out! And wallow about, you majestic ones of the flock, because your days for slaughtering and for your scatterings have been fulfilled, and you must fall like a desirable vessel! (Jeremiah 25:34)
- Yehowah's great day of accounting will start and proceed forth from the false shepherds who have lived off of the flock, the majestic ones who raise themselves up above all of the other sheep. There will remain no covert-hiding place for them. Yehowah will root all of them out and destroy them.
- And a place to flee to has perished from the shepherds, and a means of escape from the majestic ones of the flock. (Jeremiah 25:35)
- The Governing Body of Jehovah's Witnesses, her anointed remnant, her majestic ones, and all of the other tree-like leaders of Christendom will all howl, when Yehowah's sends the nations against them to despoil them. Their flocks will all scatter, and their very place will cease to exist.
- Listen! The outcry of the shepherds, and the howling of the majestic ones of the flock, for Yehowah is despoiling their pasturage. (Jeremiah 25:36)
- Yehowah's majestic one, is the Son of Man, who has come forth from the midst of Spiritual Israel today. The Son of Man has come near, and been allowed to approach to the Most High, for the Son of Man has shown Yehowah God his dedication to him to accomplish his purpose for mankind, as the greater Joseph, by feeding all of the world of mankind spiritual food from his word the Bible. My food is to do the will of him that sent me, and to fully accomplish his purpose.
- And his majestic one will certainly come to be from him, and from the midst of him his own ruler will go forth, and I will cause him to come near, and he must approach to me. For who, now, is this one that has given his heart in pledge in order to approach to me? Is the utterance of Yehowah. (Jeremiah 30:21)

- Yehowah's purpose for them was for them to have a strong place for them to grow and for them to bear fruit and become a strong people again, a majestic vine.
- To a good field, by vast waters, it was already transplanted, in order to produce boughs and to bear fruit, to become a majestic vine. (Ezekiel 17:8)
- Yehowah would be the one to make the ruler of his choice prosper and grow. Through the rulership of this righteous twig or sprout Yehowah will bring comfort or shade to his people through verdant foliage of deep understanding. Among his branches all of the righteous ones will reside. He would become a majestic cedar among God's people.
- On the mountain of the height of Israel I shall transplant it, and it will certainly bear boughs and produce fruit and become a majestic cedar. And under it there will actually reside all the birds of every wing, in the shadow of its foliage they will reside. (Ezekiel 17:23)
- The fall of Satan's worldwide system will bring lamentation to many. There are many majestic daughter nations who will also be made to fall with her. The world's entire worldwide political system must fall.
- Son of man, lament over the crowd of Egypt and bring it down, her and the daughters of majestic nations, to the land down below, with those going down into the pit. (Ezekiel 32:18)
- So Yehowah shows them, that now his people rise up against him as an outright enemy. By use of a figurative illustration, he shows that his people treat his representatives disrespectfully, like the High Priest who wears the majestic ornament. Around such ones they walk about confidently, like victors returning from the war, no longer ashamed over their sinfulness.
- And yesterday my own people proceeded to rise up as an outright enemy. From the front of a garment you men strip off the majestic ornament, from the ones passing by confidently, like those returning from war. (Micah 2:8)
- Yehowah will then call to remembrance their majestic rulers and kings and princes. Those ones will stumble as they try to escape the

destruction. They will hasten to the city's wall, yet outside of the wall another barricade will be present, preventing their escape.

- He will remember his majestic ones. They will stumble in their walking. They will hasten to her wall, and the barricade will have to be firmly established. (Nahum 2:5)
- Now Yehowah God shows that the shepherds of Assyria have become drowsy, not watchful toward the protection of their city, and her majestic ones stay in their residences. So their people will be scattered upon the mountain, other governments of the earth, and there will be no one collecting them together, as Yehowah God has promised to collect together his own people, Israel after scattering them.
- Your shepherds have become drowsy, O king of Assyria, your majestic ones stay in their residences. Your people have been scattered upon the mountains, and there is no one collecting them together. (Nahum 3:18)
- Then the lesser trees of their forest will only howl, for their majestic leaders have fallen, their popes and cardinals and bishops and priests, they have all been despoiled. Howl you massive trees of Bashan, for this impenetrable forest of religious leaders has come down. Who will shepherd the people now?
- Howl, O juniper tree, for the cedar has fallen, because the majestic ones themselves have been despoiled! Howl, you massive trees of Bashan, for the impenetrable forest has come down! (Zechariah 11:2)
- Later, upon realizing his error, and knowing that he had been rejected by Yehowah God and his Christ for his betrayal of Jesus, Judas Iscariot took the silver monies given to him to betray Jesus Christ, and threw them into the temple. Thirty pieces of silver had been the majestic price with which Judas Iscariot and his fellow conspirators had placed upon the life of the Son of God, Jesus Christ.
- At that, Yehowah said to me; Throw it to the treasury, the majestic value with which I have been valued from their standpoint. Accordingly I took the thirty pieces of silver and threw it into the treasury at the house of Yehowah. (Zechariah 11:13)

- Well then, the people gathered together there were all astounded at the majestic power of God. Now while all the men in the crowd were vocally marveling, at what had just occurred, Jesus started to speak to his disciples.
- Well, they all began to be astounded at the majestic power of God. Now as they were all marveling at all the things he was doing, he said to his disciples. (Luke 9:43)
