~MAKER (332)

[English, creator, manufacturer, producer, architect, Opposite of, destroyer]

- The incense used in the temple was the work of an ointment maker.
- Then you must make out of it a holy anointing oil, an ointment, a mixture that is the work of an ointment maker. It is to be a holy anointing oil. (Exodus 30:25)
- And you must make it into an incense, a spice mixture, the work of an ointment maker, salted, pure, something holy. (Exodus 30:35)
- He made additionally the holy anointing oil and the pure, perfumed incense, the work of an ointment maker. (Exodus 37:29)
- Each nation came to be a maker of its own gods, which they deposited in the house of the high places of the Samaritans.
- However, each different nation came to be a maker of its own god, which they then deposited in the house of the high places that the Samaritans had made, each different nation, in their cities where they were dwelling. (2 Kings 17:29)
- Job asked if mortal man can be more just than Yehowah God, or cleaner than even his maker.
- Mortal man, can he be more just, than God himself? Or can ablebodied man be cleaner than his own Maker? (Job 4:17)
- Job showed that if he bestowed titles upon other men, that his own Maker would carry him away.
- For I certainly do not know how I can bestow a title, easily my Maker would carry me away. (Job 32:22)
- Job showed that men under oppression keep seeking out assistance, but none of them look to Yehowah God their Grand Maker.

- And yet no one has said; Where is God my Grand Maker, the One giving melodies in the night? (Job 35:10)
- Job shows that Leviathan was the beginning of the works of its Maker, Yehowah God.
- It is the beginning of the ways of God, its Maker can bring near his sword. (Job 40:19)
- The Psalmist invited others to come in and bow down before their Maker, Yehowah God, for there their help resides.
- O come in, let us worship and bow down, let us kneel before Yehowah our Maker. (Psalms 95:6)
- You are the ones blessed by Yehowah, the Maker of heaven and earth. (Psalms 115:15)
- My help is from Yehowah, the Maker of heaven and earth.
 (Psalms 121:2)
- Our help is in the name of Yehowah, the Maker of heaven and earth. (Psalms 124:8)
- May Yehowah bless you out of Zion, the Maker of heaven and earth. (Psalms 134:3)
- The Maker of heaven and earth, of the sea, and of all that is in them, the One keeping trueness to time indefinite. (Psalms 146:6)
- Let Israel rejoice in its grand Maker, the sons of Zion, let them be joyful in their King. (Psalms 149:2)
- He that defrauds a lowly one has reproached his Maker.
- He that is defrauding the lowly one has reproached his Maker, but the one showing favor to the poor one is glorifying Him. (Proverbs 14:31)
- He that looks upon a poor man as of no account has reproached his Maker.
- He that is holding the one of little means in derision has

reproached his Maker. He that is joyful at another's disaster will not be free from punishment. (Proverbs 17:5)

- Yehowah God is the Maker of both rich and powerful men and poor and lowly ones at the same time.
- The rich one and the one of little means have met each other. The Maker of them all is Yehowah. (Proverbs 22:2)
- Dead flies are what cause the ointment maker's oil to bubble forth and stink.
- Dead flies are what cause the oil of the ointment maker to stink, to bubble forth. So a little foolishness does to one who is precious for wisdom and glory. (Ecclesiastes 10:1)
- In that day earthling man will truly look for his Maker. Yehowah will then raise up true worship and reveal his true self to the sons of men who search for him.
- In that day earthling man will look up to his Maker, and his own eyes will gaze at the Holy One of Israel himself. (Isaiah 17:7)
- In Hezekiah's day a tunnel was dug 1,710 feet through rock, from an outside spring to a lower pool, in the south of Jerusalem between the two walls. But the maker of it, the source of living waters of truth, who here through Isaiah has told them to build it for their own preservation, to him they did not look nor turn to him in repentance. They did not listen to his counsels and behaved so indecently, so as to make him indignant.
- And there will be a collecting basin that you must make between the two walls for the waters of the old pool. And you will certainly not look at the grand maker of it, and the one forming it long ago you will certainly not see. (Isaiah 22:11)
- The untended land, would serve as little more than a place to collect dried up twigs, for lighting a fire. All of this would come upon the Jews, spiritual Esau, because they were not a people of keen understanding! Their maker would show them no mercy, nor favor, because they were not like him, they were not spiritually minded.
- When her sprigs have dried up, women coming in will break them off, lighting them up. For it is not a people of keen

understanding. That is why its Maker will show it no mercy, and its own Former will show it no favor. (Isaiah 27:11)

- What perversity to think, that they can prevent their Maker's word and will from being known. What arrogance! Since they are clay in their maker's hands, should they not listen to his voice?
- Clearly rejecting all counsel except the counsel that comes forth from their own small circle, is a course of foolishness, an isolating of oneself. Should not such men be actively searching out every source of wisdom?
- The perversity of you men! Should the potter himself be accounted just like the clay? For should the thing made say respecting its maker; He did not make me? And does the very thing formed actually say respecting its former; He showed no understanding? (Isaiah 29:16)
- Has not Yehowah been the former and maker of Israel from its very inception? Did he not guide Jacob, and then the whole nation of Israel? Has he not also been guiding Spiritual Israel, based on the same pattern set by ancient Israel? Do not be afraid. He is with his people, Immanuel, and he will continue to discipline his people and bring them forth to a grand blessing.
- This is what Yehowah has said, your Maker and your Former, who kept helping you even from the belly; Do not be afraid, O my servant Jacob, and you, Jeshurun, whom I have chosen. (Isaiah 44:2)
- Many men think that they can do as they please with God's earth, but Yehowah has a purpose of his own for our earth. He will not leave it in the custodial care of men, who seek to ruin and destroy it. (Revelation 1:18) He originally made earth as a permanent home for the human family, and his grand purpose is what will come to be.
- For this is what Yehowah has said, the Creator of the heavens, He the true God, the Former of the earth and the Maker of it, He the One who firmly established it, who did not create it simply for nothing, who formed it even to be inhabited; I am Yehowah, and there is no one else. (Isaiah 45:18)
- In this system men have lived in constant fear and dread of the oppressive and wicked rulers under Satan's control. They have used

fear of death to keep all mankind under their control. Because of this worldwide pervasive system men have simply forgotten the ways of peace, the ways of their Maker, for they have no touchstone in them, because this oppressive system rules over all of their existence.

- And that you should forget Yehowah your Maker, the One stretching out the heavens and laying the foundation of the earth, so that you were in dread constantly the whole day long on account of the rage of the one hemming you in, as though he was all set to bring you to ruin? And where is the rage of the one hemming you in? (Isaiah 51:13)
- The Son of Man, is God's woman his loving wife, as was prophetically pictured by Sarai and Sarah in the Bible record. Yehowah is the one who has revealed himself to the Son of Man, and who has taught him through his spirit and his word, who he is, and how the Bible is to be understood.
- The woman and her true identity, has been a closely guarded sacred secret for generations. Now it is revealed by and through, that very one. Yehowah has repurchased his Son of Man, and soon all of his 144,000 sons, by bringing them back to life on earth to accomplish his further purpose. Under the Kingdom of the Son of his love, all false gods will be shown up as unrealities, and all of the earth will call Yehowah, their God and Maker.
- For your Grand Maker is your husbandly owner, Yehowah of armies being his name, and the Holy One of Israel is your Repurchaser. The God of the whole earth he will be called. (Isaiah 54:5)
- Did it not take awesome power to make the earth and to hold it in place? Look at all of the living creations, that he has made with such beauty and balance, surely they demonstrate his superior wisdom? Men imagine, that the universe is the result of an explosion, but the orderly universe that we can observe, requires our awe, as to just how it was put in place.
- He is the Maker of the earth by his power, the One firmly establishing the productive land by his wisdom, and the One who by his understanding stretched out the heavens. (Jeremiah 10:12)

- What confidence it is to know that Yehowah the Maker of the heaven and the earth is with us. As earth's maker, he knows everything about all of creation, and so there is no question, that he cannot answer for us, and no problem that he cannot solve. His interest in earth is not transient, but long-lasting and he will surely bring about all of the good things, that he has purposed regarding it.
- This is what Yehowah the Maker of earth has said; Yehowah the Former of it to establish it firmly, Yehowah being his name. (Jeremiah 33:2)
- Men with all their might cannot change the course of earth or make it spin faster or slower. Yehowah however made the earth and put it into its orbit. By his wisdom he established the productive land, and his understanding alone, he stretched out the heavens. Will mere men and their puny systems, be able to withstand his stated will and purpose?
- He is the Maker of the earth by his power, the One firmly establishing the productive land by his wisdom, and the One who by his understanding stretched out the heavens. (Jeremiah 51:15)
- Yehowah now shows Israel and Judah, just where they have fallen short. Israel has built temples filled with idols calling them her god. Judah has chosen to build fortified cities, rather than to trust in Yehowah God, their Maker, for protection. For doing such things, he promises to send fire into their cities, and he will devour their dwelling towers in both of them.
- And Israel began forgetting his Maker and building temples, and Judah, for his part, multiplied fortified cities. And I shall certainly send fire into his cities and it must devour the dwelling towers of each one. (Hosea 8:14)
- Yehowah here contrasts the wise constellation to the foolish one. His people have acted foolishly, against his grand purpose and in disregard of his wise counsel.
- Though Jehovah's Witnesses think that a new day is about to dawn around them, Yehowah will turn that day into the darkness of eternal night. He will pour out upon them a deluge or a heavenly ocean of truths, that they have so far refused to understand or even to examine.

- The Maker of the Kimah constellation and the Kesil constellation, and the One turning deep shadow into the morning itself, and the One who has made day itself dark as night, the One calling for the waters of the sea, that he may pour them out upon the surface of the earth, Yehowah is his name. (Amos 5:8)
- These men of faith were a pattern for us today, for they were waiting for the city having real foundations, the New Jerusalem, the builder and maker of which city, is God.
- For he was awaiting the city having real foundations, the builder and maker of which city is God. (Hebrews 11:10)
