## ~MALCHI-SHUA (61) (Mal'chi-shu'a) [My King Hears My Cry for Help]

- One of King Saul's sons.
- And the sons of Saul came to be Jonathan and Ishvi and Malchishua, and, as for the names of his two daughters, the name of the one born first was Merab and the name of the younger one Michal. (1 Samuel 14:49)
- As for Ner, he became father to Kish. Kish, in turn, became father to Saul. Saul, in turn, became father to Jonathan and Malchi-shua and Abinadab and Eshbaal. (1 Chronicles 8:33)
- As for Ner, he became father to Kish. Kish, in turn, became father to Saul. Saul, in turn, became father to Jonathan and Malchi-shua and Abinadab and Eshbaal. (1 Chronicles 9:39)
- He was struck down in battle by the Philistines at Mount Gilboa.
- And the Philistines kept in close range of Saul and his sons, and the Philistines at last struck down Jonathan and Abinadab and Malchi-shua, Saul's sons. (1 Samuel 31:2)
- And the Philistines kept in close range of Saul and his sons, and the Philistines got to strike down Jonathan and Abinadab and Malchi-shua, sons of Saul. (1 Chronicles 10:2)
- And his corpse, along with those of his brothers Jonathan and Abinadab and that of his father Saul, was fastened by the Philistines on the wall of Beth-shan. However, valiant men of Israel retrieved the bodies, burned them in Jabesh, and buried their bones there.
- And it came about the next day that, when the Philistines came to strip the slain, they got to find Saul and his three sons fallen upon Mount Gilboa. (1 Samuel 31:8)
- And they proceeded to cut off his head and strip off his armor and send into the land of the Philistines all around to inform the houses of their idols and the people. (1 Samuel 31:9)
- Finally they put his armor in the house of the Ashtoreth images,

and his corpse they fastened on the wall of Beth-shan. (1 Samuel 31:10)

- And as regards him, the inhabitants of Jabesh-gilead got to hear what the Philistines had done to Saul. (1 Samuel 31:11)
- Immediately all the valiant men rose up and went all night long and took the corpse of Saul and the corpses of his sons off the wall of Beth-shan and came to Jabesh and burned them there. (1 Samuel 31:12)
- Then they took their bones and buried them under the tamarisk tree in Jabesh, and they went fasting for seven days. (1 Samuel 31:13)
