(Mal'luch) [from a root meaning, reign as king, king]

- An Israelite, one of the heads of the people, whose descendant, if not he himself, attested the trustworthy arrangement made in the time of Nehemiah.
- So in view of all this we are contracting a trustworthy arrangement, both in writing and attested by the seal of our princes, our Levites and our priests. (Nehemiah 9:38)
- Now attesting it by seal there were, Nehemiah the Tirshatha, the son of Hacaliah, and Zedekiah. (Nehemiah 10:1)
- The heads of the people, Parosh, Pahath-moab, Elam, Zattu, Bani.(Nehemiah 10:14)
- Malluch, Harim, Baanah. (Nehemiah 10:27)
