

## ~MARVELOUS (85)

[English, wonderful, amazing, stunning, spectacular, excellent, awe-inspiring, splendid, fabulous, superb, breath-taking, fantastic, great, remarkable, Opposite of, **dire**]

- Job felt that Yehowah God would show himself **marvelous** in his case.
- And if it acts haughtily, like a young lion you will hunt for me, and you will again show yourself **marvelous** in my case. (**Job 10:16**)
- The Psalmist showed that he would remember the **marvelous** doings of Yehowah God of long ago.
- I shall remember the practices of Yah, for I will remember your **marvelous** doing of long ago. (**Psalms 77:11**)
- The Psalmist showed that the angels of the heavens would also laud Yehowah God for his **marvelous** acts.
- And the heavens will laud your **marvelous** act, O Yehowah, yes, your faithfulness in the congregation of the holy ones. (**Psalms 89:5**)
- The Governing Body of Jehovah's Witnesses have themselves taken on the power of kings over God's people today, and they magnify themselves above every other anointed one saying, that only what they teach is truth.
- They have acted against the God of gods by disfellowshipping God's son the Son of Man and removing other anointed ones from their midst. They customarily reject every form of new understanding sent to them, and will not listen to their God on any matter.
- And the king will actually do according to his own will, and he will exalt himself and magnify himself above every god, and against the God of gods he will speak **marvelous** things. And he will certainly prove successful until the denunciation will have come to a finish, because the thing decided upon must be done. (**Daniel 11:36**)

- Yet when the religious leaders, the chief priests and the scribes, saw what Jesus was doing, and how the boys were crying out saying; Save we pray, the son of David. Their response was to become indignant, wanting to put a stop to it, for it reproved them.
- When the chief priests and the scribes saw the **marvelous** things he did and the boys that were crying out in the temple and saying; Save, we pray, the Son of David! They became indignant (**Matthew 21:15**)
- Jesus now showed these men, that the rejection of him by the religious bodies of Israel, was something prophesied in scripture. He showed, that the stone that the builders rejected, was to become the head of the corner, or the chief cornerstone of Spiritual Israel. The spiritual temple then would be based upon this fine foundation stone. This came forth from Yehowah God, and it was **marvelous** in the eyes of faithful men. They, in rejecting the chief cornerstone, could no longer be part of that building, for it would be erected around this chief cornerstone, Jesus Christ.
- Jesus said to them; Did you never read in the Scriptures: The stone that the builders rejected is the one that has become the chief cornerstone. From Yehowah this has come to be, and it is **marvelous** in our eyes? (**Matthew 21:42**)
- Jesus then showed that this had come forth from Yehowah God's hand, and to men of faith it was something **marvelous**.
