~MARVEL (105)

[English, wonder, awesome sight, amazing thing, sensation, miracle, spectacle, phenomenon]

- The dead do not marvel, neither can they laud Yehowah God.
- For those who are dead will you do a marvel? Or will those impotent in death themselves arise, will they laud you? (Psalms 88:10)
- Will a marvel by you be known in the darkness itself, or your righteousness in the land of oblivion? (Psalms 88:12)
- Then he said to them; Pay back Caesar's things to Caesar, but God's things to God. What a simple answer and so profound that they began to marvel at his response.. He dismissed them with a single sentence, and they had no grounds whatever for criticizing him. He was not going to get involved in political squabbles, but was concerned with returning to God what was due to him, fine spiritual qualities in imitation of him. Even these opposers went away marveling over what he had said.
- Jesus then said; Pay back Caesar's things to Caesar, but God's things to God. And they began to marvel at him. (Mark 12:17)
- Yet even then, Jesus made no response, and so Pilate began to marvel over him.
- But Jesus made no further answer, so that Pilate began to marvel. (Mark 15:5)
- Then all began to give a favorable witness about him, and to marvel at the wonderful teachings coming forth from his mouth. All the while though, they were saying among themselves, was this not the son of Joseph, whom they all knew?
- And they all began to give favorable witness about him and to marvel at the winsome words proceeding out of his mouth, and they were saying; This is a son of Joseph, is it not? (Luke 4:22)
- So Jesus told Nicodemus not to marvel that he had told him, that he must be born again, for all things are possible to God.

- Do not marvel because I told you, you people must be born again. (John 3:7)
- So then Jesus showed them, that the father has affection for his Son, and so he shows him all the things he does. Jesus then prophesied, that Yehowah God would show them even greater works through Jesus, in order, for them to marvel.
- For the Father has affection for the Son and shows him all the things he himself does, and he will show him works greater than these, in order, that you may marvel. (John 5:20)
- Then he told them not to marvel because the hour was fast approaching, when he would call out with his voice, and cause all the dead within the memorial tombs to come to life again.
- Do not marvel at this, because the hour is coming in which all those in the memorial tombs will hear his voice (John 5:28)
- So the man bore witness, that it was a marvel to him, that they did not know where he came forth from, and yet he had opened his eyes. Would not anyone think this way, who was not dead set against Jesus, and prejudiced against him.
- In answer the man said to them; This certainly is a marvel, that you do not know where he is from, and yet he opened my eyes. (John 9:30)
- Paul marvels, that they are being quickly removed from Yehowah God, who called them through the undeserved kindness of Christ, over to another sort of Good News, something different, than what Paul had earlier taught them.
- I marvel that you are being so quickly removed from the One who called you with Christ's undeserved kindness over to another sort of Good News. (Galatians 1:6)
- Therefore anointed Christians should not marvel that the world led by Satan the Devil hates them, for they are like righteous Abel. They have the blessing of God, and these other ones have lost it, because their works were wicked. They are also seeking to kill or destroy these faithful anointed sons of God, and many have fallen by their wicked hands.

Do not marvel, brothers, that the world hates you. (1 John 3:13)
