∼MATRITES (17) (Mat'rites) [Of, or belonging to, Matar]

- A Benjamite family of which King Saul of Israel was a member.
- Then he had the tribe of Benjamin draw near by its families, and the family of the Matrites came to be picked. Finally Saul the son of Kish came to be picked. And they went looking for him, and he was not to be found. (1 Samuel 10:21)
- The King James Version uses the name Matri, Ma'tri. However, the Hebrew word mat-ri' here is accompanied by the definite article. Thus the New World Translation appropriately reads, the Matrites, as do other modern translations. AS, AT, RS
