~MATTITHIAH 1 (71) (Mat-ti-thi'ah)[Gift of Yehowah]

- A Levite who played a harp when the ark of the covenant was brought to Jerusalem from the house of Obed-edom.
- Accordingly the Levites stationed Heman the son of Joel and, of his brothers, Asaph the son of Berechiah, and, of the sons of Merari their brothers, Ethan the son of Kushaiah. (1 Chronicles 15:17)
- And with them their brothers of the second division, Zechariah, Ben and Jaaziel and Shemiramoth and Jehiel and Unni, Eliab and Benaiah and Masseiah and Mattithiah and Eliphelehu and Mikneiah, and Obed-edom and Jeiel the gatekeepers. (1 Chronicles 15:18)
- And the singers Heman, Asaph and Ethan, with the copper cymbals to play aloud. (1 Chronicles 15:19)
- And Zechariah and Aziel and Shemiramoth and Jehiel and Unni and Eliab and Maaseiah and Benaiah with stringed instruments tuned to Alamoth. (1 Chronicles 15:20)
- And Mattithiah and Eliphelehu and Mikneiah and Obed-edom and Jeiel and Azaziah with harps tuned to Sheminith, to act as directors. (1 Chronicles 15:21)
- And David and the older men of Israel and the chiefs of the thousands came to be the ones walking along to bring up the ark of the covenant of Yehowah from the house of Obed-edom with rejoicing. (1 Chronicles 15:25)
- Probably this same Mattithiah was one of the Levite musicians whom David put before the Ark both to call to remembrance and to thank and praise Yehowah the God of Israel.
- Then he put before the ark of Yehowah some of the Levites as ministers, both to call to remembrance and to thank and praise Yehowah the God of Israel. (1 Chronicles 16:4)
- Asaph the head, and second to him Zechariah, and Jeiel and

Shemiramoth and Jehiel and Mattithiah and Eliab and Benaiah and Obed-edom and Jeiel, with instruments of the string type and with harps, and Asaph with the cymbals playing aloud. (1 Chronicles 16:5)

- And was the individual who was later selected by lot from among the sons of Jeduthun to head the 14th division of 12 Levite musicians.
- Further, David and the chiefs of the service groups separated for the service some of the sons of Asaph, Heman and Jeduthun the ones prophesying with the harps, with the stringed instruments and with the cymbals. And from their number the official men for their service came to be. (1 Chronicles 25:1)
- Of Jeduthun, the sons of Jeduthun, Gedaliah and Zeri and Jeshaiah, and Shimei, Hashabiah and Mattithiah, six, under the control of their father Jeduthun, who was prophesying with the harp for thanking and praising Yehowah. (1 Chronicles 25:3)
- And the lot proceeded to come out, the first belonging to Asaph for Joseph, for Gedaliah the second, he and his brothers and his sons were twelve. (1 Chronicles 25:9)
- For the fourteenth, Mattithiah, his sons and his brothers, twelve. (1 Chronicles 25:21)
