~MEARAH (19) (Me-ar'ah) [Cave]

- A Sidonian city or district that remained to be conquered after Israel's campaign under Joshua's leadership ended.
- This is the land yet remaining, all the regions of the Philistines and all the Geshurites (Joshua 13:2)
- To the south all the land of the Canaanites, and Mearah, which belongs to the Sidonians, as far as Aphek, as far as the border of the Amorites. (Joshua 13:4)
- Two locations have tentatively been suggested. One is the village of Mghairiye, about 10 kilometers (6 miles) Northeast of Sidon. The other is Mughar Jezzin, Arabic for Caves of Jezzin, a district of caves atop the Lebanon Range and East of Sidon.
