(Me-co'nah) [from a root meaning, firmly establish]

- A town in southern Judah apparently near Ziklag and large enough to have dependent, or daughter, towns.
- And as regards the settlements in their fields, there were some of the sons of Judah that dwelt in Kiriath-arba and its dependent towns and in Dibon and its dependent towns and in Jekabzeel and its settlements. (Nehemiah 11:25)
- And in Ziklag and in Meconah and its dependent towns. (Nehemiah 11:28)
- Precise identification is not possible, most suggested locations are based on textual emendations.
